

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time June 13, 2021

"[The kingdom of God] is as if a man would scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how . . ." Mark 4: 26-34

Today's Gospel is about those everyday miracles we can work if we possess "mustard seed" faith: the conviction that, in the smallest acts of compassion and generosity, we can transform the most barren stretches of our lives into great gardens of hope and possibility. We may have little or no expectation of a harvest; nurturing what we have planted may be a frustrating and futile undertaking — but Christ calls us to embrace the faith of the Gospel farmer and the hope of the mustard seed: to be willing to plant whatever "seeds" of Gospel hope and compassion we possess, wherever and whenever we can, in the certain knowledge that it will, in some way, result in its own "miracle": the revelation of the kingdom of God in the everyday blessedness of our lives.

Statement from Archbishop Marcel Damphousse of the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall on the Discovery of the Remains of 215 Children at the Former Indian Residential School in Kamloops, British Columbia

"A voice was heard in Ramah, walling and loud lamentation, Rachel weeping for her children; she refused to be consoled, because they are no more."

Matthew 2:18

Like many of you, I have been deeply disturbed and sorrowful over the enormously tragic discovery of the remains of the 215 children at the Indian Residential School on Tk'emlups te Secwepemc First Nation. The pain of this great tragedy has been expressed in the many recent ceremonies, memorials and tributes across Canada. It has touched all of us who desire a world in which all life flourishes especially the life of innocent children.

Let me say to the Indigenous peoples living within the Archdiocese: with an earnest heart, I have been praying for your consolation. This discovery has aggravated the pain of those who have already been touched by the many losses encountered through the Indian Residential School system. Through my ministry as bishop of Alexandria-Cornwall and of Sault Ste. Marie, and now as Archbishop of Ottawa-Cornwall, I have had the opportunity to meet many of you. Through these encounters, you have made me aware of the continued need for healing which is the result of historical forms of colonization which persist under new guises in the present day. Let us work together for true and lasting efforts to make real the reconciliation for which we all long.

Let me say to the members of the Roman Catholic Church in Ottawa-Cornwall, who have also expressed grief for the loss of these children: let us work together with our Indigenous brothers and sisters to ensure a future in which we all thrive. Their healing is also our healing since, as Pope Francis has said, we are all interconnected (cf. *Laudato si*, No. 240). Reconciliation, which is at the heart of our Christian faith, will give us all new life, setting us free from the fear that has kept us apart (cf. *Fratelli tutti*, No. 78). I encourage pastors and all the members of our parishes to create opportunities to become aware of the causes and the need for healing and reconciliation so desperately desired in this present time.

With prayers to the Creator and Christ his Son and through the intercession of St. Joseph, the Blessed Mother and St. Kateri Tekakwitha, may we follow the Spirit in our efforts to heal broken relationships, to build trust and to commit ourselves to truthful reconciliation with the first peoples of this land — not only with our words but with our actions.

The Body and Blood of Christ Mark 14: 12-16, 22-26 June 06, 2021

[Jesus] took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them and said, "Take it; this is my body."

ROMAN LECTIONARY: Mark 14: 12-16, 22-2

Blood is one of the most powerful symbols in the world. In the Scriptures, it was believed to bear the life force and to have a sort of numinous (mystical/ spiritual/ supernatural) power. Blood that had been spilled cried out from the Earth for vengeance. Most of all, blood was used to seal treaties and covenants, signifying the seriousness of the matter and giving the covenant a binding force. Even today, we still speak of something being signed in blood. Giving one's promise and solemn word must never be taken lightly, especially regarding our commitment to the Lord and our promise of discipleship.

The sacrificial blood of animals granted ritual purity for the parties involved. The blood of Christ, however, grants purity before God, the forgiveness of sins and the gift of eternal life. Christ's sacrifice is not temporary or fleeting but permanent and eternal for God is always faithful and present.

The Last Supper was nothing less than the establishment of another covenant. This time the body and blood of Jesus would provide the seal and bond of the covenant. When believers partake of the Eucharist, it is an acknowledgement and re-enactment of this covenant. Jesus certainly fulfills His part of the covenant – He faithfully provides presence, guidance and blessings. It is a constant reminder of the price that has been paid for our liberation and redemption. But what about our obligations?

Our participation in the Eucharist is a public affirmation of fidelity to the covenant, which for us means loyalty, discipleship and willingness to follow in the footsteps of Jesus. The Lord's Body and Blood are also relational, being symbols of solidarity and reverence for the entire community of believers and ultimately all people. It is not a private devotion or personal spiritual charge for the week. It is signing on again for our journey towards the Promised Land and renewing our commitment for loving service. Rather than something that only takes place only on Sunday or at church, it is a divine pattern and way of life for all believers.

The COVID-19 pandemic has made people more aware of how interdependent everyone is and our need to be attentive to the poor and the vulnerable in our midst.

The discovery of the remains of 215 children at the Former Indian Residential School in Kamloops, British Columbia, is a great tragedy. The pain of this great tragedy has been expressed in the many recent ceremonies, memorials and tributes across Canada. It has touched all of us who desire a world in which all life flourishes – especially the life of innocent children. There is continued need for healing. Their healing is also our healing since, as Pope Francis has said, we are all interconnected (cf. Laudato si. No. 240). Reconciliation, which is at the heart of our Christian faith, will give us all new life, setting us free from the fear that has kept us apart (cf. Fratelli tutti, No. 78). There is a desperate need for healing and reconciliation in this present time. It is not only with our words but especially with our actions that we can heal broken relationships, build trust and commit ourselves to truthful reconciliation with the first peoples of this land.

In the presence of the Loving Redeemer, we cannot watch idly as others are made to suffer. Worship is the source of the wisdom and courage to speak out for greater justice in the name of the holy dignity of the human person. Prayer and worship re-create our lives. We transcend our dissolute self-focus to enter a life where our love of self and others is reconfigured through love of the Ultimate Other.

The Church is the one great hope for the world, but we, her sons and daughters, too frequently betray that hope. Yet, Mary, the Mother of the Church, is the one who restores hope. She is the living witness that through total reliance on God, all things will be well in our world eternally. Through her prayers on our behalf, the world can fulfill its eternal promise. The remedy is for our hearts to magnify the Lord, to rejoice in God's saving power and to recognize that all great things have their origins in the Mighty One.


Progress of Pastoral Youth Centre Project

Pastoral Youth Centre updates:

Thanks to the hard work of all in our parish and the professional support of the Ottawa-Cornwall Archdiocese, we have the preliminary design of the Sheng Shen Pastoral Youth Centre. The Centre will be located at the intersection of Cyrville Road and Michael Street. Its facilities would include rooms for accommodating adults of university age and those of 55+, as well as areas for worship & reflection, social and community programs.

The Centre would become a co-ordinated part of the combined activity area of the church, the Centre and the open space in-between. This will raise our potentials for all programs, liturgical, social and community. The space at the rear of the church is reserved for the Prayer & Faith Garden and for future development. The preliminary design is attached for your information. Let us pray fervently for the future of our Parish.




